

# Silverline expert

Sold as a pair, Silverline's Expert saw is the cheapest tested. Although the blade is a similar thickness to others, the set of the teeth is greater, creating a wider kerf at about 2mm. Teeth are triple ground (7tpi) and the blade coated with Teflon, which means the saw seems blunt until the coating has worn a bit. During testing I found crosscutting timber easier than ripping.

Good for larger hands, the moulded plastic handle has a rubber palm grip and is screwed to the blade. A shorter, 500mm (20in) version is available, again with 7tpi.
